Location. Nantyperchyll Woodland, Llidiad Nenog, Carmarthenshire, SA32 7RR.

The access road leading into the property is at **SN544360**. Please ensure the access gates are kept closed at all times as there are livestock on the adjacent fields to the parcel. The tracks marked red on the sale map are suitable for access by vehicle. The access tracks marked blue on the sale map are not suitable for vehicles.

Please ensure that all clothing and footwear is clean to avoid the transfer of disease.

Description.

An excellent parcel of well thinned Sitka Spruce and Douglas Fir with a high sawlog content. The stands contain some windblow although this is not aged and the majority of the blown timber is still green. Access to the parcel is straightforward with a concrete access road for haulage, the parcel should suit mechanised working throughout.

^{*}Sale Includes an area of windblown Japanese Larch, which has not been assessed for Volume. The Larch is covered by a Statutory Plant Health movement notice and the purchaser will be expected to comply with the relevant timber movement regulations

The estimates given above of the numbers, sizes and volumes of the trees are given without warranty of any sort as to their accuracy. Persons offering for the timber must satisfy themselves as to the exact size and nature of the trees offered for sale. No responsibility will be accepted for any discrepancy whatsoever for any reason at any time.

<u>Extraction</u>. The timber is to be extracted along the route marked red on the attached plan. No bands tracks, chains or tracked vehicles are allowed on the concrete access road, marked in red. Following completion of operations the extraction routes, shown in blue, must be left in a rut-free, brash-free and level condition.

<u>Lop and Top</u>. All of the lop and top from the felling must be cut into lengths not exceeding one metre and scattered evenly over the site. The use of static de-limbing machines, or harvesters, will be subject to agreement on the disposal of lop and top.

Wayleaves. There are electricity supply / telephones lines crossing the route.

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Basis of the Sale. The timber is offered for sale on a volume basis per cubic metre over bark and Offers should be priced accordingly. The contract sets out the system for measurement as follows: "The method of measurement of the timber will normally be that agreed with the Recipient of the felled timber and used on the relevant delivery notes. Where the quantity of timber is described by weight, or by volume, this unit of measurement will be the cubic metre with one metric tonne being deemed equivalent to one cubic metre by volume, providing always that measurement of the timber takes place within six weeks of felling. Where measurement is made over six weeks from felling, by the piece, or by any other agreed system the weight/volume conversion factor, the average volume of each piece or other agreed measurement will be determined by reference to Forestry Commission Booklet 39 and the appropriate tables therein."

Contract Period. All timber must be felled and removed from site by 31st December 2020.

<u>Contract Terms</u>. A copy of the Contract terms is available for inspection by request. This timber is offered for sale subject to contract and all persons offering will have been deemed to have satisfied themselves as to the Contract terms beforehand.

<u>Date for Offers</u>. All offers should be submitted to the Vendor's Agent **NOON on 13**th **August 2020.**

Acceptances. The Vendor reserves the right not to accept the highest or any offer.

<u>Subject to Contract</u>. This timber is offered for sale subject to contract, copies of which are available for inspection.
